McKeesport Produce to People Cancelled

DUQUESNE, PA (March 19, 2020) – Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank’s Produce to People food distribution in McKeesport that was scheduled for this Saturday, March 21 is now cancelled. At this time, the Food Bank does not have plans to reschedule the McKeesport distribution during the COVID-19 crisis.

This change is in addition to the cancellation of the Aliquippa Produce to People distribution that was also announced on Thursday, March 19. Due to logistics and our observation of public safety and social distancing, the Food Bank is transitioning to hosting distributions in larger parking lots in order to accommodate the increase in need.
