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**1.2 MILLION DOLLARS RAISED BY WTAE CHANNEL 4 AND THE GREATER PITTSBURGH
COMMUNITY FOOD BANK**

**Fundraiser part of the Project Community: Day of Giving
#WTAEcommunity**

(Pittsburgh, PA. April 16, 2020) – WTAE Channel 4 and Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank have raised **\$1,238,248** in less than twenty-four hours via *Project Community: Day of Giving* to help feed neighbors amid the Covid-19 crisis. The largest single day fundraising in the 62-year history of WTAE Channel 4.

The virtual telethon, held throughout the day April 15th, successfully raised the equivalent of more than **6.1 million meals** for area communities. Viewers donated through “text to give” and online options; 84 Lumber, Nemaquin Woodlands Resort, Edgar Snyder and Associates, and The Meredith Group at Hefren-Tillotson gave generous match fund donations.

“When Pittsburgh’s Action News 4 showed the miles-long lines of cars waiting for food a week ago, we knew Pittsburghers would step up to help,” said WTAE President & General Manager, Charles W. Wolfertz III. “Local broadcasters have the unique ability to respond quickly and reach the masses in a time of crisis. We are proud we could be of service to our neighbors and our partners at the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank, when they need it most.”
