



1. If thunderstorms are in the forecast for the time of a distribution, the distributions team will send out a text message alert to registered guests that the event may be delayed if a thunderstorm commences during the distribution time.

2. The person in charge will suspend the event and initiate protective measures for the staff and attendees. The distributions team will use a large sign to place near the distribution space to notify guests of the delay who are still waiting in their cars.

3. The staff and attendees will move to a safe shelter:

- A building such as a home, school, church, office building or indoor recreation center
- A safe vehicle is any fully enclosed metal-topped vehicle such as a hard-topped car, minivan, bus or truck

4. Shelter in place for 30 minutes after hearing the last sound of thunder or seeing lightning. After 30 clear minutes, the event will be safe to resume.
